The Gospel Message:

- Humanity was created for **relationship** with God.
- Our sin separated us from that **relationship**.
- There was nothing we could do to reconcile the **relationship** on our own.
- Jesus lived a sinless life.
- Jesus died on the cross to pay the penalty for our sin.
- Jesus rose again on the third day that we might have life.
- Jesus offers eternal life (or a reconciled **relationship**) to those who will repent of their sin by placing faith in Him.
