## PRAISES

- God blessed the Good Friday and Easter Sunday services in a huge way. We had 928 people on Good Friday and 2,555 people on Easter Sunday. On Easter, we filled the Worship Center, the Fellowship Center, and the Chapel. We saw 29 professions of faith and five people baptized.
- All of our mission teams were able to go, serve, and get home safely. We praise God for almost 70 people serving on missions in the last month.
- The Albany Biblical Counseling Center held its first banquet and more than 170 people were in attendance and significant funds were raised for the ministry.
- The Lord blessed our April Serve Day – 17 members prayed over 104 homes in the Sweetbriar Road/Twinflower Road neighborhood and 13 volunteers delivered 14 bunkbeds to homes in our community where kids needed a place to sleep. The Hope Center hosted a handiwork Life Skills class where four volunteers taught three young men about simple skills in the home. Five members visited the homes of six guests who recently visited Sherwood. We served with the Homeless Coalition at Tift Park – 200 meals were provided and one person placed faith in Jesus.
